Description:

Construction of the Fall River Bus Terminal

These 5309 Bus Discretionary funds in the amount of \$950,000 will be used by the Southeastern Regional Transit Authority (SRTA) for the construction of a new bus depot/passenger terminal at 118 Fourth Street in Fall River, MA. The new bus depot will serve all 11 SRTA bus routes operating in Fall River, as well as all intercity operations serving Fall River. The single story, 2400 square-foot building will have space for passenger amenities, including ticket sales, waiting space with seating, restrooms for the public and separate restrooms for the drivers. The site layout will include spaces for pick up/drop off, bus berths for SRTA buses, and transit supportive parking spaces. Construction is projected to begin in October 2011 and the facility will be open for revenue service in April 2013. The total project is projected to cost \$4.8 million.

All administrative and statutory requirements have been met.
